Forklift Training Guidelines

It is vital that all workplaces making use of forklifts have the following checklist or one equivalent on the premises. If all of the safety regulations are being followed, each of these questions should be answered with a "yes". A "no" to whichever question indicates a procedural flaw which could cause damage to equipment, accident or injury.

- 1) Is the forklift operating area separated from pedestrian traffic?
- 2) Is pedestrian access to forklift travel areas restricted by barriers?
- 3) The walkways for pedestrians are well-marked?
- 4) A sign is visibly clear stating a "lift truck in operation"?
- 5) Are mirrors for pedestrians and drivers provided at blind spots?
- 6) Changes or alterations to the daily lift truck schedule has been communicated to workers?
- 7) Are lift truck tires suitable for use on all operating surfaces?
- 8) Forklift seatbelt is being used?
- 9) The forklift seat is in good condition?
- 10) Is a regular forklift maintenance schedule adhered to?
- 11) Are yearly checks of the forklift being carried out?
- 12) Is the type of forklift right for the tasks?
- 13) Is there a readable load chart on the forklift?
- 14) Could the operators read and understand the load chart?
- 15) Does the chart list the safe capacity for different uses and attachments?
- 16) Are the warning devices on the forklift working correctly?
- 17) Is the operating speed control device fitted properly?
- 18) The forklift overhead cage is fitted correctly?
- 19) Have all forklift operators obtained certification?
- 20) Speed limits and warning signs are being observed?
- 21) The operators have current training for the forklifts being used?
- 22) Do operators understand their responsibilities to report any machine damage and forklift incidents?
- 23) Prior to the equipment being operated, the pre-test checklist is being reviewed each and every day?
