Marysville Boom Lift Operator Training - A cherry picker is a type of aerial work platform. Cherry pickers include a platform or bucket at the end of a hydraulic lifting system. The machine is likewise called a man lift, boom lift, hydraladder or basket crane.

The platform or bucket is sometimes mounted to or set unto a truck or other motor vehicle and is sometimes known as a bucket truck. Other motor vehicles that could be made use of are self-moving platform, stand-alone trailers or flat back pickup vans. The person working stands inside the bucket and works from there. The person within the bucket often consists of an upper set of controls allowing manipulation of the bucket's position. The bucket's reach can be extended on some models by telescoping to be able to adjust the lifting arm. Automatic safety controls prevent tipping. Articulated boom lifts are suggested for working within tight spaces or when it is necessary to clear obstacles.

Cherry pickers, as the name implies, were first made for picking fruit in trees at high levels. These machines are often utilized in various industries such as construction, mining and exterior painting. Sometimes they are made use of for cleaning windows on high structures. The machines are utilized to service electrical equipment, telephone and cable television on utility poles. Fire fighters occasionally utilize cherry pickers, know as snorkels, when ladders are inadequate. During Christmas season, civic workers could be seen in cherry pickers hanging lights and banners.
