Marysville Aerial Lift Training - An aerial work platform is a mechanized access platform. This machinery provides access to otherwise inaccessible places for equipment or people. Likewise called an aerial device or elevating work platform, the machinery is usually used to access high areas. Maintenance and construction workers often must utilize aerial work platforms on the job. They are used by firefighters for emergency access.

Intended for temporary use, aerial work platforms are different from elevators, that provide permanent access to high places. An aerial work platform is intended to be operated by a single individual, and can lift weights of not more than one ton. Several kinds have higher load limits. There are a variety of types of aerial work platforms; like for instance, there is a "scissor lift" and a "cherry picker".

Some aerial work platforms are available equipped with electrical outlets or compressed air connectors for power tools. For specialist tasks, such as lifting frames for window glass, an aerial work platform may come together with special equipment.

Anybody needed to operate an aerial lifting machine requires training, together with their superiors. Members of Health & Safety Committees and representatives responsible for inspecting aerial device work areas likewise have to undergo training. Trainees would become familiar with aerial lifting device operation. They will also know the rules which apply to the safe use of these devices. Regulations vary within different provinces, and within worksites which are federally regulated.

Any worker who is needed to be lifted by or work near an aerial lifting machine must be informed about possible dangers. In a general safety session, an Aerial Lift Training Video could be shown to educate all of the staff who work near them or are lifted by them.

Aerial Lift Training Program comprises modules focused on the following: Aerial Lift Devices and Operating Controls; Hazard Identification; Platform Positioning & Park Positioning and Pre Operational Checks for Aerial Lift Devices. The program is meant to train staff on safely utilizing self-propelled, elevated work platforms and boom supported, self-propelled, elevated work platforms. Workers who finish the program will receive a certificate, signed by a qualified person to verify successfully completing a hands-on practical exam.
